The Spirits Production Manager at Coldstream Clear leads and performs many distilling, fermentation, and blending duties for the spirits production team. The Spirits Manager will work alongside supply chain manager and spirits packaging team. The Spirits Production Manager will be required to develop a strong knowledge of distilling to manage and direct distillers and troubleshoot equipment when needed.
